21. A 细节理解题。根据“Once you have applied pressure to reduce bleeding, take your pet immediately to a vet for assessment”可知，在受重伤的时候，最佳方案仍是寻求兽医帮助，故选 A。
22. B 细节理解题。根据全文最后一句话“If it was lilies or sago palm, I would recommend getting them to a vet, even if they're not showing signs of illness, just because that can typically be life-threatening.”可知，只要食入 sago palm 不论有无症状，都应及时送医，故选 B。
23. D 体裁判断题。根据第一段及小标题可知，全文是介绍宠物受伤或中毒后如何急救，据此推测该文应该是来源于动物关爱指南，故选 D。

阅读理解 B

24-27 CDAB

本文是一篇记叙文，主要介绍了一名英国青年穿高跟鞋爬山，历经艰辛后成功登顶的故事。

24. C 词义推测题。从上一句“Ben Nevis is definitely not the world's most difficult mountain to climb.”以及 But 其后的内容可知，此行颇为艰难，故选 C。
25. D 细节理解题。从第二段倒数第二句“serve as his application project”可知，故选 D。
26. A 推理判断题。根据文章第三段对 shoes 和 weather 的描述可知，攀爬难度系数不小，故选 A。
27. B 推理判断题。从攀爬的过程及目的可知，虽困难重重，但 Ben 却迎难而上并成功登顶，并为无鞋可穿的孩子们筹得善款，是个鼓舞人心的积极故事，故选 B。

阅读理解 C

28-31 ABCA

本文是一篇说明文。主要讲述了三名中国古生物学家发现了一条古鱼化石，经过进一步研究证明了大约 4.5 亿年前，生活在水中的物种进化出了颌骨(下颚)的猜想是正确的，在其研究领域具有重要的意义。

28. A 细节理解题。根据第一段“three Chinese paleontologists were playfighting during a break from working in the Chongqing Province, China”可知，他们是在工作之余打闹时发现的化石，故选 A。
29. B 词义推测题。根据第一段最后一句“Inside, a very impressive fossil lay undisturbed, preserved for millions of years.”可知，化石是躺在地上，被保存了数百万年之久(未被动过)，故选 B。
30. C 推理判断题。由第三段“but there had yet to be any fossils that supported this theory”可知，虽然科学家之前怀疑大约 4.5 亿年前，生活在水中的物种进化出了颌骨(下颚)，但迄今为止还没有任何化石支持这一理论，所以该鱼化石的发现非常重要，故选 C。
31. A 主旨大意题。本文从第一段引出化石的发现，随后介绍了其在研究领域具有重要的突破性，故选 A。

阅读理解 D

32-35 DBCA

- 本文是一篇说明文，介绍新兴智能玩具在全球玩具大会上的亮相，并对其不同功能予以说明。
32. D 细节理解题。从第二段“virtual images”可知，故选 D。
33. B 推理判断题。从第三段最后一句“he thinks of this as a companion”可知，故选 B。
34. C 推理判断题。从第四段“getting her feelings expressed out”可知，故选 C。
35. A 主旨大意题。全文简介玩具大会的展出品及其性能功能，从最后一段可知，此类玩具的功能就是提升 emotional intelligence，故选 A。

第二节

36-40 AEDFG

本文是一篇说明文。作者就如何获得人生智慧给出了建议，帮助读者更好地面对充满挑战的世界以及生活中的困境。

36. A 根据前文，作者提出话题“we need to be wise”。后文“Let me tell you this, wisdom provides us with perspectives when we need it and it calms us down in terrible situations.”(让我告诉你，当我们需要的时候，智慧会给我们提供视角，在糟糕的情况下，智慧会让我们冷静下来)可知，这里是在说智慧带来的好处。所以 A 项“Why is wisdom crucial in this modern world?”起到承上启下的作用，故选 A。
37. E 本空位于段首，是该段落的中心句，根据后文“This will open up new pathways for us. Never base your perspective on ...”可知，your perspective, a judgement-free space for ideas 是关键词，本段主张应学会接受不同的观点，所以 E 项“...being open to diverse perspectives”符合文意，故选 E。
38. D 根据上文“...be the kind of person who learns something new every day. Take new classes, read books and the list goes on and on.”以及后文“All of these activities will help you to tackle problems ...”可知，空处应承接上文，列举学习新事物的一些具体方式，且 D 项中的“clear out your problems”与下文中的“tackle problems”相呼应，故选 D。
39. F 该空位于段尾，是对前文的总结，根据前文“...the best way is to have wise people as your mentors ...then engage in useful dialogue with them.”本段的主要内容为“以智者为师”，所以 F 项“By spending more time with them, there will be more transfer of knowledge to you.”与本段主题相符，且 F 项中的“them”与上文中的“them”相呼应，故选 F。
40. G 选项中“Communicating with others and helping them out”与上文中“share it with others”相呼应，故选 G。

第三部分 英语知识运用

第一节 完形填空

本文是一篇记叙文。文章主要讲述了主人公是一位努力想在高中第一天就给大家留下好印象的学生，但走进教室后发现与老师撞衫了，这让她的自我介绍在紧张和尴尬中开始。然而，老师幽默地化解了她的尴尬，也让她明白，很多时候不必过分在意一些不重要的小事。

41. A 考查动词词义辨析。句意：当木制衣架前后移动时，无数的想法在我的脑海里闪过。raced“想法、头脑、心脏(因为害怕、兴奋等)快速运动/运转”；broke“打破”；forced“强迫”；wandered“漫步”。根据下文“through my brain as wooden hangers moved back and forth”可知，这里 race through my brain 表示“在我的脑海里飞快穿梭”，展现出作者纠结开学第一天应该穿什么，以给未来的同学留下良好的第一印象的情绪，故选 A。
42. B 考查名词词义辨析。句意：第一印象就是一切。Experiences“经历”；impressions“印象”；comments“评论”；expectations“期待”。根据上文“It was my first day of high school in a new State”可知，这是作者高中开学第一天；从后文“and it was necessary to impress the people who I'd spend the next four years with”可知，作者认为给未来四年的同学留下好印象很有必要，故选 B。
43. D 考查形容词词义辨析。句意：频繁搬家对一个孩子的成长会产生影响。Random“随机的”；Permanent“永久的”；Regular“有规律的”；Frequent“经常的”。根据上文“this was my third time being the new kid”可知，作者第三次当新生，所以是经常搬家导致的，故选 D。

44. B 考查动词词义辨析。句意：我艰难地努力去找可靠的朋友。managed“成功”；struggled“（在困难中）挣扎、努力；refused“拒绝”；agreed“同意”。根据上文“but the fact that this was my third time being the new kid”可知，作者频繁搬家，因此找到稳定可靠的朋友对她来说是很困难的，故选 B。

45. A 考查动词词义辨析。句意：但是这一次，爸爸的公司确保了我可以在同一个地方从头上到尾上高中。ensured“确保”；admitted“承认”；rejected“拒绝”；deserved“应得”。前文主人公因频繁搬家交友困难，由“但是”可知，这一次情况不同于以前，不会再搬家了，故选 A。

46. C 考查名词词义辨析。句意：在扫荡一番衣柜后，我骄傲地穿着一件完美的有设计图案的连衣裙出现。根据后文“But my jaw dropped to the floor when I found Mrs. Hutfilz, my English teacher, wearing the exact same dress as I did.”“我”和英语老师穿了一模一样的连衣裙可知，我穿的是一条连衣裙。shirt“衬衫”；uniform“制服”；dress“裙子”；skirt“半身裙”，故选 C。

47. D 考查形容词词义辨析。句意：当我从校车上下来时，我感到很有信心。根据上文“I emerged proudly in a perfect patterned dress after riding my closet”可知，主人公对这件连衣裙非常满意，所以她应该处于一个非常自信的状态。nervous“紧张的”；doubtful“怀疑的”；competent“有竞争力的”；confident“有信心的”，故选 D。

48. D 考查动词词义辨析。根据上文可知，主人公发现与老师撞衫了，应该处于一个很尴尬的状态；从“I kept my head down”和后文“but the first day meant 49 in front of the class”可知，主人公并不想被大家注意到，于是低着头偷偷走到座位上。crawled“爬行”；dragged“缓慢而费力地移动”；elbowed“用肘挤”；tiptoed“蹑手蹑脚地走”，故选 D。

49. A 考查名词词义辨析。句意：我低着头，蹑手蹑脚地走到座位上，但是第一天意味着在全班面前做自我介绍，并且很快就轮到我了。因为是开学第一天，所以新同学要自我介绍。introductions“介绍”；performances“表现”；lectures“讲座”；debates“辩论”，故选 A。

50. D 考查副词短语辨析。句意：我终于度过了那几分钟的演讲，直到 Hutfilz 站起来，开玩笑地说她很喜欢我的风格。从后文“I was relieved to make a humorous and genuine 54 with my first teacher”可知，老师是幽默地化解了尴尬。hesitantly“迟疑地”；carefully“小心翼翼地”；honestly“诚实地”；jokingly“开玩笑地”，故选 D。

51. C 考查名词词义辨析。句意：整个早上积累起来的焦虑令人吃惊地没有了。sympathy“同情”；thrill“激动”；anxiety“焦虑”；jealousy“嫉妒”。根据下文“that had accumulated throughout the morning”可知，这个早上主人公本来想给同学留下好印象，却和老师意外撞衫，应该一直处于紧张、焦虑的状态，故选 C。

52. B 考查动词短语辨析。句意：整个早上积累起来的焦虑令人吃惊地没有了。根据上文“surprisingly”可知，这里意思是指持续了整个早晨的焦虑惊奇地一下子就融化掉，消失了。took off“起飞、脱下”；melted away“融化、消散”；passed down“传承”；carried on“继续”，故选 B。

53. C 考查动词词义辨析。句意：当我和同龄人咯咯地笑时，我的笑容越来越浓。根据下文“as I giggled with my peers”可知，主人公心情放松下来后，自我介绍也渐入佳境。用 grow 表示笑意的增长、扩大。froze“冻住”；faded“逐渐消失”；grew“增长”；generated“产生、引起”，故选 C。

54. A 考查名词词义辨析。句意：能和我的第一位老师建立起一段幽默而真挚的联系，且这段联系会在将来的几年持续下去，我感到很宽慰。根据“humorous”和“which would last for the coming years”可知，这里指的是主人公因为老师幽默化解撞衫尴尬而跟老师建立起的联系。connection“联系”；adjustment“调整”；agreement“协议”；negotiation“协商”，故选 A。

55. B 考查动词词义辨析。句意：这件事提醒了我，高中是玩耍、努力学习、创造回忆的时候，而不是为不重要的细节而紧张的时候。根据前文，主人公因为想给同学们留下好印象，精挑细选穿着，却与老师撞衫，开学第一天的早上在焦虑和紧张中度过。而老师的幽默化解让她重新放松下来，因此主人公有感而发，通过这件事重新想起了高中生活的意义。advised“建议”；reminded“提醒”；informed“通知”；revealed“揭露”，故选 B。

56. C 考查名词词义辨析。句意：这件事提醒了我，高中是玩耍、努力学习、创造回忆的时候，而不是为不重要的细节而紧张的时候。由上文主人公放下紧张后和同学们一起笑、和老师倾诉可知，她通过这件事明

白，自己的紧张是没有必要的，而是要享受和同学、老师的相处，且第一天的这件事也成为了高中生活难忘的回忆。images“图像、意象、形象”；senses“感觉”；memories“回忆”；choices“选择”，故选C。

57. A 考查形容词词义辨析。句意：这件事提醒了我，高中是玩耍、努力学习、创造回忆的时候，而不是为不重要的细节而紧张的时候。由上文可知，主人公精挑细选穿着、又跟老师撞衫，整个早上在紧张不安中度过。经历这件事后，她重新想起高中生活应该做的事：“have fun, work hard, and make memories”，而不是因为像衣着这样的不重要的细节而焦虑。unimportant“不重要的”；complex“复杂的”；accurate“精确的”；vital“至关重要的”，故选A。

58. C 考查动词词义辨析。句意：回想起来，我花在担心演讲上的十分钟真的不值得。根据上文“I kept my head down and tiptoed to my seat, but the first day meant introductions in front of the class, and soon enough it was my turn”可知，作者在演讲前因为和老师撞衫而惴惴不安。doubting“怀疑”；considering“考虑”；fearing“担忧、害怕”；regretting“后悔”，故选C。

59. C 考查连词词义辨析。句意：虽然我中学的开始并没有完全按照我的预想发展，但是Hutfilz老师很棒的风格无疑以最好的方式将那一天变得难忘。这里2个分句应是转折语气，体现出主人公开学第一天从预料外的尴尬紧张到充实愉悦的转变。Until“直到”；Since“自从”；While“虽然”；If“如果”，故选C。

60. D 考查名词词义辨析。句意：虽然我中学的开始并没有完全按照我的预想发展，但是Hutfilz老师很棒的风格无疑以最好的方式将那一天变得难忘。由上文“I made it through my minute speech, until Hutfilz stood up, 50 adding she liked my style”可知，这里的style一语双关，既是主人公模仿老师半开玩笑地称赞老师和自己一样的时尚品味，也是称赞老师机智幽默处理问题、教书育人的风格和人格魅力。morality“道德”；honor“荣誉”；pride“自豪”；style“风格”，故选D。

61. was awarded, 考查谓语动词的时态、语态。award作动词意为“颁发、授予”，樊锦诗在九月七日被授予表彰，九月七日为具体过去时间，故使用一般过去时的被动语态。主语“樊锦诗”为单数，故填was rewarded。

62. Called, 考查非谓语的用法，该句后文主谓结构齐全，she started...，所以called是非谓语作状语，指主语she被称为“敦煌的女儿”，使用过去分词表被动。

63. to work, 考查不定式，the chance to do sth.表示“有机会做某事”。

64. that/which, 考查定语从句，根据上文可知，“樊有机会在莫高窟工作，一个...的地方”，该句修饰的是先行词a place。从句中缺主语，因此用that/which指代先行词充当从句主语成分。

65. completely, 考查副词，“莫高窟几乎完全与世隔绝”，completely副词，修饰动词短语were cut off。

66. what/whatever, 考查宾语从句，主句主语为Fan and her coworkers，谓语动词为stayed和do，从句作do的宾语。从句they could (do)为避免重复省略了do，因此从句缺少宾语。该句意为“做她们能做的事”或“做她们能做的任何事”，因此用what/whatever来充当从句宾语成分。

67. The, 考查冠词，the number of表示“...的数量”，该句意为“到访敦煌的游客人数在增加”。

68. causing, 考查非谓语的用法，主句The number of tourists... was increasing主谓结构齐全，所以causing是非谓语作状语，指游客增加这件事情造成内部的壁画褪色，使用现在分词表主动。

69. by, 考查介词，by chance意为“偶然地”，该句意为“在20世纪80年代后期，樊偶然了解到了计算机技术”。

70. exploration, 考查名词，前文of为介词，后接名词，因此用exploration，意为“在超过三十年的探索后”。

第四部分 写作

第一节 短文改错

1. 考查名词复数形式。句意：在所有有教育意义的谚语中，我最喜欢的是“有志者事竟成”。proverb“谚语”是可数名词，由该句的 all 可知，此处为名词的复数形式。故将 proverb 改为 proverbs。
2. 考查定语从句。句意：在所有有教育意义的谚语中，我最喜欢的是“有志者事竟成”，这句话 告诉我们应该坚持我们的梦想。分析句子可知，逗号后是非限制性定语从句，先行词是那句谚语，从句缺少主语，应用关系代词 which 引导。故将 who 改为 which。
3. 考查动名词。have difficulty (in) doing sth.“做...有困难”，所以 adapt 改为 adapting。
4. 考查结果状语从句。句意：...我的学习很差，几乎不可能赶上我的同学。此处为 so...that...“如此.....以至于.....”引导的结果状语从句，其中 so 后面直接接形容词或副词。故将 such 改为 so。
5. 考查介词。catch up with sb. “赶上某人”。
6. 考查代词。lost heart“灰心”为固定短语，所以此处代词 my 多余。故将 my 删掉。
7. 考查连词。句意：再努力一点，你就会成功的。这是祈使句的用法，故将 or 改为 and。
8. 考查动词时态。根据语境中的 devoted 和后文 became，这里还是在描述当时的情况，也应该使用一般过去时。故将 adjust 改为 adjusted。
9. 考查冠词。句意：心之所愿，无事不成。根据句意及空后 willing heart 为单数名词可知，此处为表示泛指“一颗心甘情愿的心”为泛指概念，结合 willing 的发音是辅音音素开头，所以为不定冠词 a。故在 to 后加 a。
10. 考查副词。分析句子可知，此处为需要副词修饰动词 succeed。故将 definite 改为 definitely。
